Join your neighbors:

Better, cheaper service:

Unlike what most people think, you will save money if you annex: People love our garbage, recycling, and yard trash service, and these services are bundled in to the taxes you pay (unlike the separate \$323.70 annual solid waste fee now on your tax bill). In other words, so your real estate tax bill should go down. You'll save on your water and sewer bill, too! How can you join the City?

If you are the owner of one of the properties listed below, you just need to sign the annexation petition that has been prepared. If enough signatures are received (75% of the "freeholders", owning 75% of the assessed value in the area), the area can be annexed into the City. **To set up an appointment to sign, or if you have more questions, contact:**
