ACCESSORY STRUCTURE

A structure that is:

- Subordinate to and serves a principal building;
- Subordinate in area, extent or purpose to the principal building served;
- Designed for the comfort, convenience or necessity of occupants of the principal use served;
- Located on the same lot as the principal building served.
- Not be erected closer than three feet to any side or rear property line;
- Not be erected within five feet of any main building unless proposed structure is open on all sides;
- Not be erected within a required front yard.

Examples: Gazebo, Storage Shed, Pergola, Chicken Coop, Greenhouse, etc...

**Disclaimer: After review, Zoning staff may determine that the proposed accessory structure requires a building permit and all relevant building inspections.*
